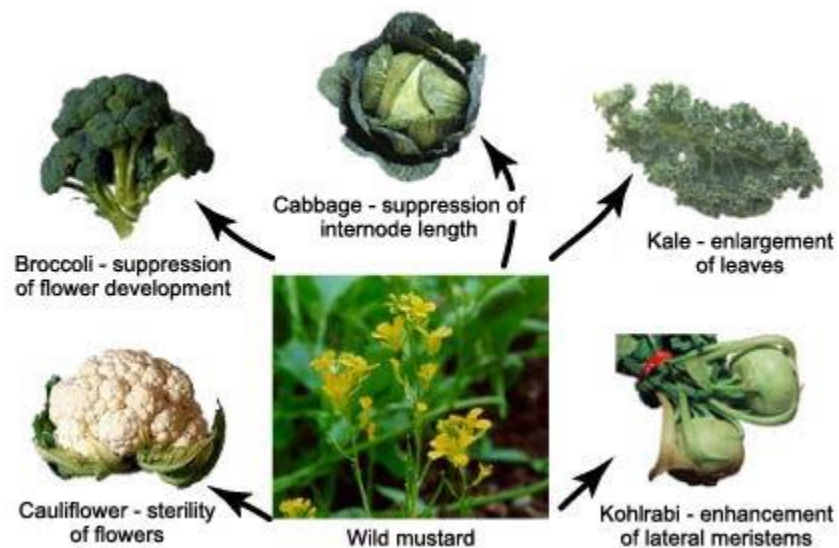


Artificial Selection

A process in which humans consciously select **for** or **against** particular features in organisms. For example, the human may allow only organisms with the desired feature to reproduce or may provide more resources to the organisms with the desired feature. This process causes evolutionary change in the population over time, and is analogous (the same as) to natural selection, only with humans, not nature, doing the selecting.
